Out-of-State Entry Information:	Participating teams must be from schools that are recognized members of their state associations affiliated with the National Federation of High Schools (NFHS). All non-Massachusetts schools that plan to attend the Boston Holiday Challenge must send the meet director an email declaring the school's intent to participate. This is a non-binding declaration used to inform the sanctioning bodies of potential participants. The deadline for this declaration is December 9, 2022.
Meet Description:	This is a multi-state high-level meet for selected athletes on your team who have met the entry standards. All events other than the weight throw and the pentathlon have a required entry standard that must have been met in a prior meet performance.

Mandatory Paperwork and Forms:

Single Waiver:

- All teams must submit the MSTCA Single Waiver Form for the Indoor Season prior to their team being allowed to compete in any meets.

Participation Rules:

- M.I.A.A./NFHS rules will be in effect, including enforcement of the uniform rule.
- An athlete may participate in no more than **2 running events and 1 field event**.
- A relay counts towards the running event limit.
- Competitor numbers must be worn on the front of the uniform, including relays.

Hurdles Trials: Girls followed by Boys; Seeded based on entry time, fast to slow; Fastest 8 advance to the Final.

Dash Trials: Girls followed by Boys; Seeded based on entry time, fast to

slow; Fastest 8 advance to the Final.

Hurdle Finals: Girls before Boys **Dash Finals:** Girls before Boys

Order of Events (continued):

OVAL - 1:00 p.m. - Check-in in the gym; Girls followed by Boys

Freshman One Mile Run: Sections on time, fastest section last

One Mile Run: Sections on time, fastest section last 600 Meter Run: Sections on time, fastest section last* 1,000 Meter Run: Sections on time, fastest section last 300 Meter Dash: Sections on time, fastest section last*

Note: The 300 meters will be run in lanes the entire race at MSTCA meets

and in the MIAA Championship meets. There will be NO cut-in.

Two Mile Run: Sections on time, fastest section last

4 x 200 Meter Relay: Sections on time, fastest section last.*
4 x 800 Meter Relay: Sections on time, fastest section last.
4 x 400 Meter Relay: Sections on time, fastest section last.*

*Lane preferences for these events: 5-6-4-3-2-1.

- The Meet Director may delay the relays until after the high jump concludes.
- The 4 x 200m Relay will have a 3-turn stagger.
- The 4 x 800m Relay will have a 2-turn stagger.

Entry Fees:

\$10 per individual event; \$25 per relay; \$50 per pentathlon entry

Each school must notify Jayson Sylvain, the MSTCA's Chief Financial Officer, at mstca.cfo@gmail.com of its payment plan for the entry fees prior to the day of the meet.

- If a school is using the MSTCA's Single Payment method, the school should notify the MSTCA via email and include any Purchase Order number which is attached to the Single Payment.
- If a school is paying with a Purchase Order for this meet only, the school should notify the MSTCA of the PO number via email.
- If a school is paying by check in advance, the school should mail the check to the address listed below and notify the MSTCA via email.
- If a school is paying by cash or check on the day of the meet, the school should notify the MSTCA of this intent via email.

Entry Lists:	Entry lists will be posted on www.mstca.org by Friday, December 23.
Equipment:	 Teams must provide their own relay batons. Teams must provide their own Weight Implements Shots and blocks will be provided by meet management. Teams cannot use their own. Please do not bring them.
High Jump:	 Girls Opening Height: 4' 6" Boys Opening Height: 5' 6" Height progression will increase by 2 inches. The "Five Alive" rule will be used until only six jumpers remain in the competition.
Long Jump:	 Each jumper will be allowed three jumps. The top 7 jumpers (+ties) will advance to the Finals for three additional jumps. Best flights will jump last. No runbacks are allowed. Athletes should come prepared with a mark.
Shot Put:	 Each thrower will be allowed three throws. The top 7 throwers (+ties) will advance to the Finals for three additional throws. Best flights will throw last.
Weight Throw:	 Meet Officials will verify all implements. Each thrower will be allowed three throws. The top 7 throwers (+ties)will advance to the Finals for three additional throws. Best flights will throw last.
Awards:	 Top 6 finishers in each event will receive medals. There will be a trackside awards ceremony for each event as soon as the event is done and results are available. Please make sure your athletes are present at this ceremony and in their school issued uniform. There are no team awards.
Results:	 Results will be posted after the meet on www.mstca.org Live results will be available at https://live.mstca.org/
Spikes:	 Only 1/8" or 1/4" Pyramid spikes are allowed at R.L.C. Spikes are allowed ONLY in the track area.

	 Correct spikes will be sold in the gym. Anyone using needle spikes or longer spikes than recommended will be disqualified for the remainder of the meet. 	
Inclement Weather:	 Any decision to cancel the meet because of inclement weather will be made by 6:00 a.m. on meet day. Notification regarding cancellations will be posted on our website www.mstca.org and our Twitter account @MSTCA1 and emailed through Direct Athletics to your school's contact. There is no make-up date. 	
Parking at Reggie Lewis Center:	Parking is available for patrons attending track and field events at the Reggie Lewis Center on a first-come-space available basis in Parking Lot 2 on weekdays and Lots 2 & 3 on weekends. Both lots are located along Columbus Ave less than 1/4 mile from the RLC. Lot 2 is at the corner of New Heath Street, and Lot 3 is at the corner of Center Street.
