Meet Description:	With modest entry standards due to the time needed to contest the distance events, this developmental meet is designed to accommodate most of your distance runners. Please do not enter athletes who will not be able to meet the entry standards. The pentathlon, previously contested as part of the Boston Holiday Challenge over the holiday week, has been moved to the Distance Classic due to the expanded schedule of the Holiday Challenge meet. Participation Rules:

- MIAA/NFHS rules will be in effect.
- Athletes entered in any events other than the pentathlon may participate in no more than <u>2 running and 1 field event</u>. Athletes over-entered will be automatically scratched from excess events by meet order.
- A relay counts toward the running event limit. Schools may enter multiple relay teams per relay event.
- Competitor numbers must be worn on the front of the uniform, including relays.

- Late Entry Policy: There are NO late entries accepted for any MSTCA meets.

Performance Lists and Results:	Entry lists/performance lists will be posted on <u>live.mstca.org</u> by Wednesday, December 25. Live results will be available at the same site.
Equipment:	 Teams must provide their own relay batons. Shot puts and starting blocks will be provided by meet management. Teams can not use their own.
Multi's - Pentathlon:	 55m Hurdles will be randomly seeded with 4 athletes per heat; girls before boys. Boys will contest the shot put in the cage sector and girls will contest the shot put in the outside-the-cage sector, as the event must conclude in time for the open shot put competition at 10:00am. Long Jump: athletes will have three attempts; no runbacks allowed. High Jump: opening height determined by meet management in consultation with the athletes. All field events will be measured in metric. The 800m/1000m will be contested as one heat for the girls 800m and one heat for the boys 1000m at an appropriate time during the distance classic. Athletes will have a minimum of 30 minutes between events.

Parking:	Parking is available in Parking Lot 2 on weekdays and Lots 2 & 3 on weekends. Both lots are located along Columbus Ave less than 1/4 mile from the RLC. Lot 2 is at the corner of New Heath Street, and Lot 3 is at the corner of Centre Street.
Inclement Weather:	 Any decision to cancel the meet because of inclement weather will be made by 6:00 a.m. on meet day. Notification regarding cancellations will be emailed through Athletic.net to your school's contact. There is no make-up date.
Awards:	There are no awards for this meet, except for the Pentathlon (Top 8 receive medals).
Spikes:	 Only 1/8" or 1/4" Pyramid spikes are allowed at R.L.C. Anyone using needle spikes or spikes longer than 1/4" will be disqualified for the remainder of the meet. Spikes are allowed ONLY in the track area—not the hallways or basketball gym. Correct spikes will be sold at the Run House store.
Shot Put:	 Half the flights (the higher seeds) will be in the cage and half the flights (the lower seeds) will be in the corner to the left of the scoreboard. All rotational throwers should still be registered via athletic.net, but coaches should also complete the form linked here to be placed in the cage regardless of seed: Rotational Shot Form Girls will compete first, simultaneously in both circles. Boys will follow when the relevant circle becomes available. If boys and girls entries combine for five flights or fewer, only the cage will be used. Each thrower will be allowed three throws. There will be no finals.
Para Events:	Entries are set up to receive athletes in the 1000 meters and shot put, as these are the events designated by the MIAA for athletes in the three para categories (Blind/Visually Impaired; Para-Ambulatory; Wheelchair). Athletes wishing to be entered in other events, should contact the meet director.
