Awards Medals to finishers 1-25 in each race. Medals will be distributed in the chute.

Team Plaques will go to the top 2 Teams in the Championship 5k.

Entry Information and Limits

- There is no need to declare which athletes are in which races prior to the date of the meet.
- Up to 10 athletes may be entered in each of the Championship races. Coaches are <u>not</u> required to enter any athletes in the Championship races.
- An unlimited number of athletes may be entered in the Open 3K races, but all athletes should be able to finish the race within 20 minutes.
- Younger athletes may be entered in the Junior/Senior 3K races, but older athletes may <u>not</u> be entered in the Freshman/Sophomore 3K races.
- The middle school races are limited to athletes in Grades 5 8.
- The Championship races are open to teams from both the Large and Small Divisions.

- NEW FOR 2023: All entries are done on <u>athletic.net</u>.
- No late entries will be accepted.

Entry Fees: \$21 per individual \$230 max per gender per school if 25 entries or less \$360 max per gender per school if over 25 entries

For example, if a school enters 30 girls and 20 boys, the total entry fee for the school would be \$590.

** <u>Please note these are entry fees, not participation fees</u>. Once the entries close, each school is responsible for paying the total fee for its entries, regardless of how many relay teams actually compete.

** NEW FOR 2023: Each school must notify the MSTCA <u>using this form</u> of its payment plan for the entry fees <u>prior to the day of the meet</u>.

MSTCA Single Waiver

Each school must have their Principal and/or AD complete the online <u>2023 Single Waiver</u> by September 6, 2023. A link to the waiver is also available in the Coaches Corner at <u>www.mstca.org</u>. Please note a school must have this form submitted before its athletes will be allowed to race in any MSTCA meet this season.
