Team must complete the MSTCA Outdoor Track SINGLE WAIVER before first meet 'B' teams are allowed in all events except for field events, 4 x 1600 Meter Relay & Distance Medley Relay. THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO 'C' TEAMS IN ANY EVENT. Prior to 11:59 p.m. on Friday, April 19, a coach may request only to the Meet Director to enter an excellent 'B' team in a field event, the 4 x 1600 Meter Relay, or the Distance Medley Relay. The Meet Director will require a list of the names and estimated performances of each member of both the 'A' and 'B' teams before deciding whether or not to approve the 'B' team. **Entry Procedure RUNNING EVENTS** • All entries should be submitted on www.athletic.net • Prior to the deadline, enter a seed time for each event the school plans to race • On athletic.net, one athlete must be added to each entry team. You can select more if you want, but you will not be held to your selection(s) made on the entry Upon receiving their declaration sheet at the meet, a coach may change their seed time to make it **SLOWER ONLY** No new relays may be added after the entry deadline Scratches will still be taken at the meet FIELD EVENTS: • Prior to the entry deadline, enter the names of each individual field competitor on www.athletic.net No new relays may be added after the entry deadline • Field event entries without the names of three athletes will be rejected Scratches/Changes will still be taken at the meet **Payment Info Entry Fees** • \$30 per relay entry, A or B teams **Payment Forms:** \*\*Payment must be arranged IN ADVANCE of any meet that your team will attend. Regardless of payment method, please complete the SINGLE PAYMENT FORM prior to the day of the meet. \*\* Please note these are entry fees, not participation fees. | Facility Information | <ul> <li>Southeastern Regional is a 6-lane composite track with an 8-lane straightaway</li> <li>Vehicle parking may be limited at each facility. Bus parking may be off-site. Please plan accordingly</li> <li>MSTCA Relay T-shirts will be on sale at all sites. Food will be available for purchase at the concession stand</li> </ul>  |  |  |
| Pole Vault           | <ul> <li>Pole vault will take place at Andover High School at 3:00 PM on Thurs. April 25</li> <li>There is one pole vault pit with a composite runway at Southeastern Regional</li> <li>Competitors must declare opening height before the start of competition. They must take their first jump at that height</li> <li>If a member of a Pole Vault team does not make his/her opening height, the entire team is eliminated from further competition and cannot score</li> <li>Jump limits: If there are 1-6 teams entered in the event; there will be no limit, if there are 7-9 teams, there will be a 9-jump limit per athlete; if there are 10+teams, there will be a 6-jump limit</li> <li>There are no runbacks allowed per NFHS rules</li> <li>Opening heights and progressions:</li> <li>Boys: 7'6" then progress 6" at each height</li> <li>Girls: 6'0" then progress 6" at each height</li> </ul> |  |  |
| High Jump            | <ul> <li>Each competitor will be allowed a total of six attempts in the competition.</li> <li>Each competitor must declare an opening height.</li> <li>The "Five Alive" rule will be used until only six jumpers remain in the competition.</li> <li>All three field event athletes must post a mark for the team to score in the event.</li> <li>If a competitor fails to clear her/his opening height, all other jumpers on the team will be eliminated from further jumping.</li> <li>The formula for Opening Heights and Progressions will be as follows: <ul> <li>Opening Height will be 8" below the MIAA Qualifying Standard</li> <li>Second Height will be 3" above the Opening Height</li> <li>Third Height will always be the MIAA Qualifying Standard</li> </ul> </li> </ul>   |  |  |

| Long Jump            | <ul> <li>No runbacks are allowed. Athletes should come prepared with a mark</li> <li>There will be one long jump pit with a painted board</li> <li>All athletes will get 3 attempts, all legal attempts will be measured in metric units</li> </ul>   |  |  |
| Triple Jump          | <ul> <li>No runbacks are allowed. Athletes should come prepared with a mark</li> <li>There will be one triple jump pit with four painted boards at 24′, 28′, 32′, 36′</li> <li>All athletes will get 3 attempts, all legal attempts will be measured in metric units</li> </ul>   |  |  |
| Shot Put             | <ul> <li>There will be one shot put sector at the facility</li> <li>All athletes will get 3 attempts, all legal attempts will be measured in metric units</li> </ul>  |  |  |

| Javelin Throw                  | <ul> <li>There will be one javelin sector at the facility using a grass runway</li> <li>All athletes will get 3 attempts, all legal attempts will be measured in metric units</li> <li>Schools must provide javelins weighing 600g or 800g and meeting NFHS specifications. There are no runbacks allowed per NFHS rules</li> </ul>  |
| Discus                         | <ul> <li>There will be one discus sector at the facility</li> <li>All athletes will get 3 attempts, all legal attempts will be measured in metric units</li> <li>Schools must provide discus weighing 1 kg or 1.6 kg. and meeting NFHS specifications</li> </ul>   |
| Equipment                      | <ul> <li>There are no blocks used in any running event relays</li> <li>Participating schools must bring their own throwing implements</li> <li>Participating schools must provide their own relay batons</li> </ul>  |
