Team trophies for the top three teams in the Varsity Divisions.

Entry Information and Limits

- A maximum of 10 runners may be entered in the Varsity races.
- An unlimited number of athletes may be entered in the Frosh and Junior Varsity races.

- All entries are done on <u>athletic.net</u>.
- No late entries will be accepted.

Entry Fees:\$21 per individual\$140 max per gender per school (\$280 maximum per school if both b/g attend)
