Discus	 There will be one discus sector on the field adjacent to the track All athletes will get three attempts in the trials Top 7 athletes will qualify for finals, and receive three more attempts Schools must provide discus weighing 1 kg / 1.6 kg. and meeting NFHS specs. There are no runbacks allowed per NFHS rules
