9:00 am	Coed Relay #1 (2 Boys & 1 Girl) - 4.6 miles (Girl is middle leg)
9:37 am	Coed Relay #2 (2 Girls & 1 Boy) - 4.6 miles (Boy is middle leg)
10:15 am	Freshman/Sophomore Girls Relay - 4.6 miles
10:55 am	Freshman/Sophomore Boys Relay - 4.6 miles
11:32 am	Junior/Senior Girls Relay - 4.6 miles
12:11 pm	Junior/Senior Boys Relay - 4.6 miles

Awards: Medals to the top 10 teams in each race.

Relay teams may collect their medals by the registration tent after the official results

are posted.

Entry Information and Limits

- Each relay team must consist of 3 runners.
- The first two legs will run 1.5 miles while the anchor leg will run 1.6 miles.
- For the order in the Coed races please refer to the Schedule.
- There is no limit on the number of relay teams a school may enter in each race.
- Teams do not need to bring batons, the MSTCA will supply relay bracelets for each team.
- The anchor leg will wear the team's bib and must finish with the bracelet.

Entry Deadline Tuesday, September 3rd, 2024 at 8:00 p.m.

- All entries are done through this form.
- A coach can edit her/his entries through 8:00 p.m. on September 3rd.
- No late entries will be accepted.

Entry Fees: \$35 per relay if entering 4 teams or less

\$175 per school if entering 5 to 7 teams

\$275 per school if entering more than 7 teams

- ** <u>Please note these are entry fees, not participation fees</u>. Once the entries close, each school is responsible for paying the total fee for its entries, regardless of how many relay teams actually compete.
- ** Each school must notify the MSTCA <u>using this form</u> of its payment plan for the entry fees <u>prior to the day of the meet</u>.

MSTCA Single Waiver

Each school must have their Principal and/or AD complete the online <u>2024 Single Waiver</u> by September 6, 2024. A link to the waiver is also available in the Coaches Corner at <u>www.mstca.org</u>. Please note a school must have this form submitted before its athletes will be allowed to race in any MSTCA meet this season.

MSTCA Emergency Contact Form

Each coach should complete the <u>MSTCA Emergency Contact Form</u> prior to participating in any MSTCA event this fall. The MSTCA's Athletic Trainers need this information on hand in case they need to alert a coach of an athlete's status.
