Participation Rules:	 MIAA rules will be in effect. NFHS Uniform rules will be enforced. Team must complete the MSTCA Outdoor Track <u>SINGLE WAIVER</u> before first meet 	
Team/Athlete Participation	 Each school may enter between 1 and 6 athletes Three athletes score as a team (A and B teams allowed) Teams must be declared prior to the start of competition A coach must accompany every athlete competing at this meet 	
Entry Fees	 \$50 per individual athlete \$135 for a Team of Three Each school must notify Jayson Sylvain, the MSTCA's Chief Financial Officer, at mstca.cfo@gmail.com of its payment plan for the entry fees prior to meet day If a school is using the MSTCA's SINGLE PAYMENT method, the school should notify the MSTCA via email and include any Purchase Order number which is attached to the Single Payment. If a school is paying with a Purchase Order for this meet only, the school should notify the MSTCA of the PO number via email. 	

	 If a school is paying by check in advance, the school should mail the check to the address listed below and notify the MSTCA via email. Awards	 Plaques will be awarded to the top 5 individuals Plaques will be awarded to the top 3 teams T-shirts will be awarded to each event winner and the top 20 individuals.
Results	Results will be posted on www.mstca.org, the official MSTCA web site.
Spikes	Only 1/8" or 1/4" PYRAMID spikes allowed. Anyone using needle spikes or longer spikes than recommended will be immediately disqualified and banned for the remainder of the meet.
Facility Information	Vehicle and bus parking are on site. There will be no concession stand.
High Jump	 2 high jump pits will be used Each athlete must declare an opening height Athletes may take no more than 6 total jumps in the competition Opening height will be determined by the meet director and will move in 5 cm increments.
Long Jump	 No runbacks are allowed. Athletes should come prepared with a mark Athletes will be given 3 attempts- no finals All fair attempts will be measured in metric units
Triple Jump	 There will be one triple jump pit with painted boards at 20', 24', 28', 32', and 36' Each athlete will receive 3 attempts All fair attempts will be measured in metric units.
Shot Put	 Athletes will be given 3 attempts- no finals All fair attempts will be measured in metric units Athletes must bring their own implements.
Javelin Throw	 Athletes will be given 3 attempts- no finals All fair attempts will be measured in metric units Athletes must bring their own implements Burlington HS will use one grass runway
Discus	 There will be one discus sector in use Each athlete will receive 3 attempts All fair attempts will be measured in metric units.
Equipment	 Blocks will be provided by the host school Participating schools must bring their own throwing implements
Order of Events	All athletes will begin and end each day with the stated running events. Seeding for running events will be random, except for the 1500 meter. Field event rotations will be assigned by the meet director prior to the meet, and may go in any order.

Emergency Contact Form	All coaches must have filled out a <u>MSTCA EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM</u> online before being allowed to retrieve your packet for your team. You only need to complete this form once for the season (unless coaches or contact info changes).
