- Athletes may participate in no more than <u>1 running</u>, <u>1 field and 1 relay event</u>.
- A school may enter only one relay team per relay event.
- Competitor numbers must be worn on the front of the uniform, including relays.

Shot Put: Girls followed by Boys. Very Important - New procedures. See note below in the shot put section.

Long Jump: Open runway for practice. See note below in the long jump section.

High Jump: Check in begins on the infield at the conclusion of the Dash & Hurdles. Two Jumping Pits; Girls and Boys compete simultaneously.

INFIELD - 10:00 a.m. - Girls followed by Boys

Hurdles Trials: Girls followed by Boys; Seeding based on entry time, fast to

slow; Fastest 16 advance to a two-section Final.

Dash Trials: Girls followed by Boys; Seeding based on entry time, fast to slow;

Fastest 16 advance to a two-section Final.

Hurdle Finals: Girls followed by Boys. **Dash Finals:** Girls followed by Boys.

OVAL - 10:45 a.m. - Girls followed by Boys

One Mile Run: Sections on time, fastest section first.
600 Meter Run: Sections on time, fastest section first.*
1,000 Meter Run: Sections on time, fastest section first.
300 Meter Dash: Sections on time, fastest section first.*

Note: The 300 meters will be run in lanes the entire race at MSTCA meets

and in the MIAA Championship meets. There will be NO cut-in.

Two Mile Run: Sections on time, fastest section first.

Shots and blocks will be provided by meet management. Teams cannot use their own. Please do not bring them. **High Jump:** • In order to hit both the 4' 9" (Division 3) and 4' 10 (Divisions 1, 2, 4, 5) MIAA qualifying marks, the Girls' High Jump progression will be as follows: 4' 5", 4' 7", 4' 9", 4' 10", +2" • In order to hit both the 5' 8" (Divisions 2, 4, 5) and 5' 9" (Divisions 1, 3) MIAA qualifying marks, the Boys' High Jump progression will be as follows: 5' 2", 5' 4", 5' 6", 5' 8", 5'9", +2" The "Five Alive" rule will be used until only six jumpers remain in the competition

Long Jump:

- There will be NO long jump registration, competition, or fee for this meet. From 9:00 am until the end of the meet athletes will be able to sign-up for 30 minute sessions of access to the long jump (15-18 athletes per group).
- During the 30 minutes, all of the athletes in the group will be able to utilize the long jump—whether doing run-throughs, short approach work, full jumps, or any other drills. There will be NO run backs allowed and NO measuring jumps (though a tape measure will be out to see approximations).
- It being an early-season meet our aim is to allow more athletes access to the
 long jump area, knowing that many lack indoor jumping facilities at their schools.
 There will be an official on hand to coordinate and a raker, but otherwise athletes
 will be expected to fairly alternate amongst themselves to make effective use of
 their time block.
- There is NO guarantee of getting a time slot. There will be sign-up sheets available for every 30-minute session on a first come, first served basis in the morning.

Shot Put:

 NOTE NEW SHOT PUT PROCEDURES for 2022-2023: Girls and Boys will no longer compete simultaneously. Whichever gender is first in the order of events will have half of their flights (the lower seeds) in the outside-the-cage sector nearest the bleachers on the home stretch and half of their flights (the higher seeds) in the cage.

ALL rotational throwers should contact the meet director to throw in the cage, regardless of seed.

When the event begins, one gender will be simultaneously competing in both throwing circles. The other gender's flights will begin in the assigned circles, as soon as the previous gender is no longer competing in the relevant circle.

Example: If 4 flights of girls shot put and 4 flights of boys shot put, the 2 best girls flights will be assigned to the cage and the other 2 flights to the outside sector. The first flight assigned to each sector (flights 1 and 3 in this scenario) would begin simultaneously.

When the girls were finished in the cage, the first boys flight assigned to the cage would start their warm-ups, and similarly for the outside-the-cage sector.

When an odd number of flights exist, the break between the two sectors will be determined by meet management.

IF boys and girls entries combined total 5 or fewer flights, only the cage sector will be used, with girls followed by boys.

Each thrower will be allowed three throws. There will be no finals.

Awards:

There will be no awards at this meet.

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| Spikes: | Only 1/8" or 1/4" Pyramid spikes are allowed at R.L.C. Spikes are allowed ONLY in the track area. Correct spikes will be sold in the gym. Anyone using needle spikes or longer spikes than recommended will be disqualified for the remainder of the meet. | |
| Inclement Weather: | Any decision to cancel the meet because of inclement weather will be made by 6:00 a.m. on meet day.
